CLARIFYING/REPHRASING

I think you misunderstood what I said.

What I meant to say was...
(rephrase something in a way that makes it clearer)

In other words...

INTERRUPTING/ASKING TO CONTRIBUTE

I'm sorry to interrupt, however...

If I may come in here...

I'd like to raise a point/an issue...

I'd like to add something...

If I could speak for a moment...

Would you like to contribute something?

PERSUADING

Do you see where I'm coming from?

Can you see my perspective?

Can you see my point of view?

Put yourself in my shoes.

Put yourself in my position.
