

Weekly Book Club Roles & Responsibilities

60-Second Summarizer

Give a short overview of the reading (in 60 seconds).

- Include the main events in order.
- ➔ Skills: summarizing, sequencing, time awareness

Vocabulary Builder

Choose **5-7 useful words** you didn't know before.

- Try to pick words you might use in other conversations.
- Share each word's meaning and make a new sentence.
- ➔ Skills: vocabulary acquisition, sentence construction

Sound Spotter

Find **5-7 words** that are hard to pronounce.

- Look for long words, silent letters, or words that don't sound like their spelling.
- Practice saying them in full sentences.
- ➔ Skills: pronunciation, confident speaking

Connection Maker

Make connections between the story and one or more of the following:

- Your personal life or native culture
- News/current events
- Other stories/books you know
- ➔ Skills: critical thinking, cultural discussion

Emotions Explorer

Choose a moment in the book that made you feel something strongly.

- Explain what you felt and why.
- Use specific **emotion words** (e.g., worried, proud, disappointed, hopeful).
- ➔ Skills: emotion vocabulary, empathy, personal expression

Word Artist

Pick a scene. Help your group "see" it by using **sensory, descriptive language**.

- Who is there? What's happening? Where is it happening? What does it look like? Feel like? Sound like? Smell like? Taste like?
- ➔ Skills: descriptive language, visualization, adjectives

Fact Finder

Research and share one interesting fact about South Sudan. It can be about history, geography, culture, food, language, or current events.

- Explain why you chose it and how it connects to the story.
- ➔ Skills: research, presentation, cultural awareness.
